USES:

- We use the present simple to talk about things that happen regularly.
I go to school at 8 o'clock.
- We also use the present simple to talk about facts that are generally true.
The Sun rises in the east.

HOW TO MAKE HE / SHE / IT FORMS

- Most verbs : + -s work—works know—k knows
- s, -sh, -ch, -x : + es pass—passes wash—washes teach—teaches mix—mixes
- Exceptions : go—goes do—does have -has

AFFIRMATIVE

I work you work he/she/it
Works we work they work

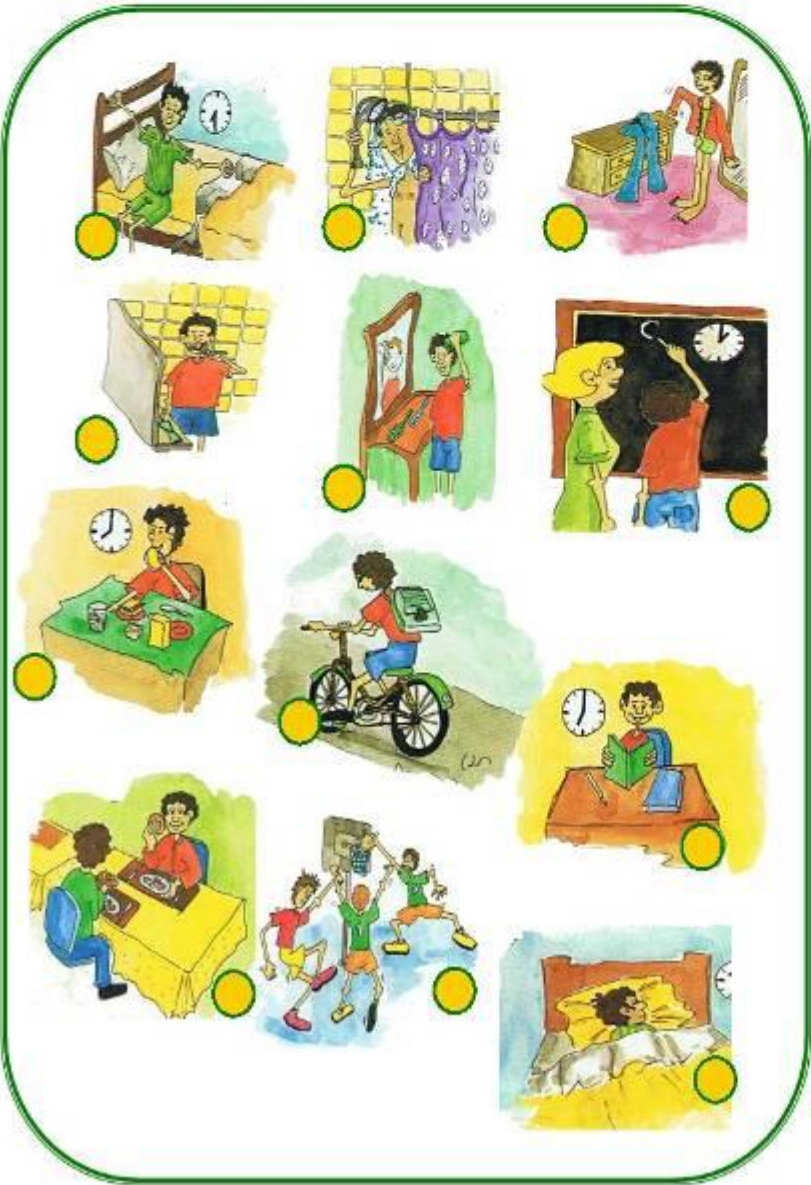
QUESTIONS - We make the simple present questions with do / does + subject + infinitive without to)

Do I work? do you work? does he/she/it work?
do we work? Do they work?

NEGATIVE - We make the simple present negatives with do / does + infinitive (without to)

I do not work you do not work he/she/it does
not work we do not work they do not work
